**Key Responsibilities** 

Supervises and coordinates all activities with personnel and equipment engaged in erecting and operating machines used to hoist, lift, convey and move any equipment or material.

- Maintains and upkeeps all maintenance and certification records on all lifting machinery and equipment including bridges cranes, gantry cranes, cables, slings, chains, hooks, clevises, shackles, lift rings, chain hoists, cable hoists and pins.
- Ensures all operators and rigging crew are currently qualified to operate and conduct rigging while maintaining their qualification records.
- Ensures compliance with physical pre-inspection performed by all users of all lifting machinery and equipment including bridges cranes, gantry cranes, cables, slings, chains, hooks, clevises, shackles, lift rings, chain hoists, cable hoists and pins.
- Develops and submits complete lift plans for all Heavy lifts to HSE prior to attempting it.
- Ensures all personnel engaged in rigging operations wear their required P.P.E.
- Identifies and coordinates crane/crew hiring and scheduling based upon lift requirements
- He ensures that the riggers, the Crane Operator and any other person involved in the lift are familiar with and follow the safe system of work and the details and limitations recorded in the lifting plan.
- The safe working load (SWL) is never exceeded, other than for the express purpose of testing a crane under the supervision of a competent person.
- Ensures that cranes do not operate in any weather conditions that exceed the limit stated for that type of crane.
